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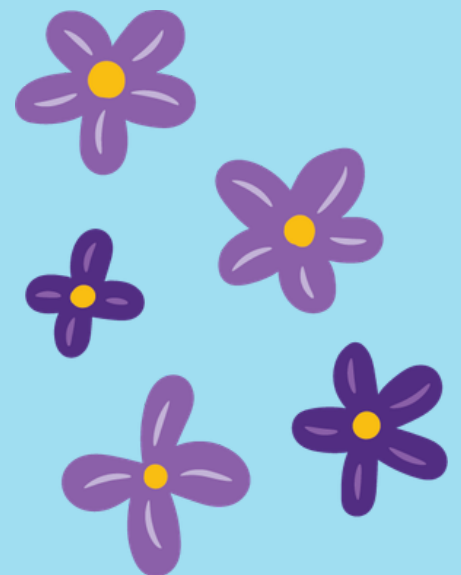

Tips for Hitting Your Girl Scout Cookie Program Goals

Now is a great time for troops to check their progress and make a plan to reach their goals! Here are a few simple strategies that can make a big difference:

Schedule One More Booth Sale

Even one additional booth sale can help girls close the gap to their goal. Consider high-traffic locations like grocery stores, community events, or weekend sports complexes.

Use Digital Cookie to Reach More Customers

Encourage girls to send personalized emails or texts through Digital Cookie to family, friends, and neighbors who may not live nearby.

Practice the Cookie Pitch


A confident greeting can increase sales! Try simple phrases like: “Hi! Would you like to support my Girl Scout troop by buying some cookies today?”

Know Your Inventory

Check which cookies are selling the fastest and make sure you bring plenty of those to booth sales.

Focus on the Goal

Remind girls what they are working toward—whether it’s a troop trip, community project, or fun experience. When girls share their goal with customers, people are often more excited to support them.

Every conversation, booth sale, and link share helps girls build skills and move closer to their goals. Keep up the great work!

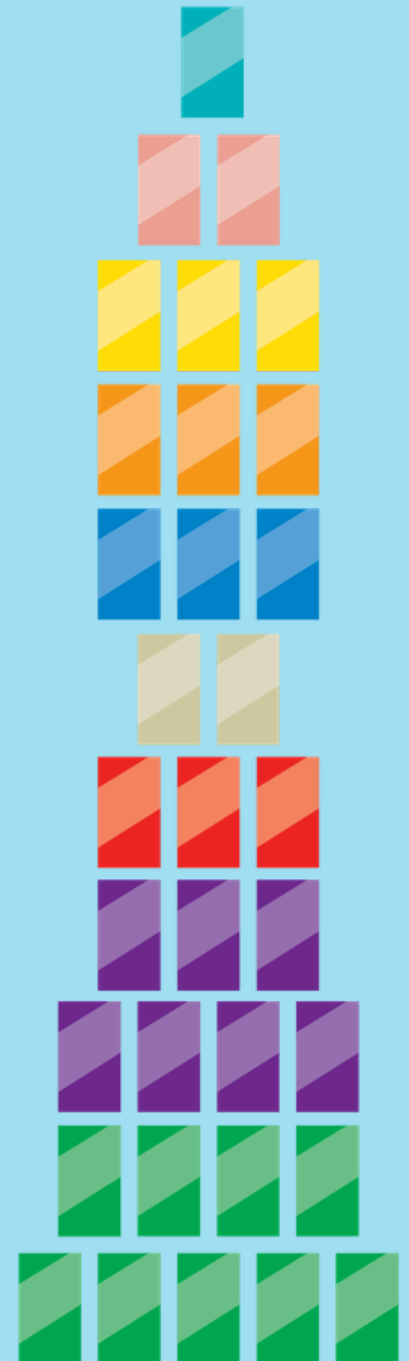
It's Cool to be at Zero

Troop Cookie Volunteers: don't forget to credit your Girl Scouts with all additional packages they've sold. Your goal is to get the bottom line of the Girl Order Tab in eBudde to zero by the end of the program. All zeros on this line mean that you've successfully sold all packages received into the troop and that girls are getting credit for selling them.

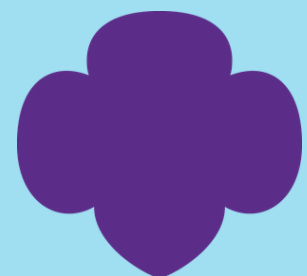
